NOTES: Red Heart yarn, medium worsted weight is a good inexpensive yarn to use for learning stitches. If you use lighter colors, you will be able to see the stitches better. Any questions, call Kay at 623-544-5976.

#1. For the Level 1 Class, you will need one skein of yarn and two crochet hooks, sizes I and J.

#2. For Level 2 Class, students may want to purchase 3-6 skeins of different colors. There are 6 patterns that we will work on in class. If you have a skein for each pattern, then you can practice the pattern in class and leave the yarn attached for more practice at home. If you have only 1 skein, then you will have to cut the yarn in order to start another pattern. Hooks, sizes I and J will work well.

#1. For Sewing Basics, you will need a sewing machine, the cords and attachments, about ½ yard of inexpensive, medium-heavy weight, woven

fabric, a spool of **Coats All Purpose** thread, and a pair of **sharp** scissors. (To better see stitches, contrast thread and fabric.)

#2. In this class, we will make a pillow and a decorative cover with a zipper. (The pillow will fit into the cover.)

For the pillow, you will need: inexpensive fabric, Coats All Purpose thread, Poly-fil to stuff pillow. (Amounts of stuffing and fabric will be

determined by the size of the pillow you will plan to make.)

For the cover, you will need: fabric, Coats All Purpose thread to match fabric, and one polyester coil zipper 2" shorter than one side of the pillow. (Fabric yardage and size of zipper will be determined by the size of the pillow you will plan to make.)

You will also need the basic sewing supplies: sewing machine, cords and attachments, scissors, straight pins (longer ones with bead heads are easier to use), container for pins, and a "see through" ruler. (DRAFT N' CUT BY "EZ" is a good one. Can be purchased at Walmart or JoAnn's.)

#3. You may choose to sew one of the following: either a skirt, pants, shorts, or pajama bottoms. The pattern you choose must have **elastic in**

the waistband. You will need to know all the things taught in the Sewing Basics Class. You will need to purchase your pattern, fabric, and notions before class. Having the pattern pieces separated and pressed will save class time. You will also need the basic sewing supplies

(sharp scissors, straight pins with container, fabric carbon paper and tracing wheel, fabric chalk, etc.)

NOTES:

Students must be 9 years or older.

Students will need **the basic sewing supplies:**

- Sewing machine with cords and attachments
- Sewing machine needles, size 80/12 or 90/14 (multiple size packets are best)
- Straight pins (long pins with bead heads are easier to use)
- Container for pins ("Glad" flat storage containers with snap on lids work well)
- "EZ DRAFT N' CUT" see-through ruler (2"x 18" with large black numbers)
- Sharp **sewing** scissors ("Fiskars" are a good, inexpensive brand. Don't cut paper with them!)
- Fabric chalk (light and dark)

FOR PILLOW:

- About ½ yard of fabric of your choice (See * at bottom)
- COATS All Purpose Thread to match fabric
- Bag of Poly-fil stuffing

FOR BAG:

- About ½ yard of fabric of your choice (See * at bottom)
- COATS All Purpose thread to match fabric
- Optional: decorative handles or cord for straps (Straps can be made from fabric.)
- Optional: iron-on transfers

*Medium weight fabrics are easier to sew on. Some types of cotton, denim, or trigger will work well.) Avoid thin, slippery fabrics.
